
NOTICE TO ALL UNION COUNTY MUNICIPALITIES, SOLID WASTE COLLECTORS & HAULERS, MATERIALS RECOVERY FACILITIES AND OTHER SOLID WASTE FACILITIES REGARDING TIPPING FEES AND HOLIDAY SCHEDULES FOR SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL OF TYPES 13, 13C, 23 AND 27 GENERATED IN THE COUNTY OF UNION AND DISPOSED OF AT THE CANADIAN PACIFIC RAILWAY (CPR), NEWARK, N.J.

Pursuant to the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection's (NJDEP) Certification of the Union County District Solid Waste Management Plan, all Solid Waste Types 13, 13C, 23 and 27 generated within the County of Union, whether collected by a Union County municipality itself (i.e., municipal DPW), or on behalf of such municipality by contract with a solid waste collector, or whether collected by private solid waste collectors (via contracts or otherwise), from residential generators, governmental generators and /or industrial generators within the County, **must be delivered** to the Canadian Pacific Railway (CPR) facility located within the Oak Island rail yard I at 91A Bay Avenue, Newark, New Jersey 07105.

Please be advised that effective, January 1, 2010, CPR is entitled to a \$0.50 per ton increment in the tipping fee under its contract with Union County Utilities Authority (UCUA). As a result, effective January 1, 2010, the aggregate disposal fee will be \$92.01 per ton for all Solid Waste Types 13, 13C, 23 and 27 generated within the County of Union and delivered at Newark, CPR facility. For your convenience, on the reverse of this notice is our 2010 holiday schedule.

The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) has certified the Union County District Solid Waste Management Plan and authorizes the UCUA as the implementing agency responsible for enforcing waste flow within Union County.
