**NOTICE TO ALL UNION COUNTY MUNICIPALITIES, SOLID WASTE COLLECTORS
& HAULERS, MATERIALS RECOVERY FACILITIES AND OTHER SOLID WASTE
FACILITIES REGARDING REGULATORY FLOW CONTROL OVER ALL SOLID
WASTE TYPES 13, 13C, 23 AND 27 GENERATED IN THE
COUNTY OF UNION**

Pursuant to the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection's (NJDEP) September 18, 2008 Certification of the February 15, 2007 Amendment to the Union County District Solid Waste Management Plan, all Solid Waste Types 13, 13C, 23 and 27 generated in the County of Union, is hereby directed to Delaware and Hudson Railway Company, Inc., d/b/a/ Canadian Pacific Railway located within the Oak Island Rail Yard at 91A Bay Avenue, Newark, New Jersey, 07105.

Accordingly, effective January 1, 2009 all Solid Waste types 13, 13C, 23 and 27, generated within the County of Union, whether collected by a Union County municipality itself (i.e., municipal DPW), or on behalf of such municipality by contract with a solid waste collector, or whether collected by private solid waste collectors, through contracts, or otherwise, from residential generators, governmental generators, commercial generators and/or industrial generators within the County, **must be delivered** to the Canadian Pacific Railway facility for solid waste disposal services. For your convenience, directions to the facility are included on the reverse of this notice.

Please be advised, effective January 1, 2009 the tipping fee at the Canadian Pacific Railway facility will be \$91.51 per ton for all Union County generated solid waste types 13, 13C, 23 and 27 generated in the County of Union. To establish a dumping account or questions regarding the Newark facility, please contact Sandra McCrimmon at (973) 274-1818.

The Union County Utilities Authority intends to vigorously enforce the Union County District Solid Waste Management Plan as amended and certified by the NJDEP. Please feel free to contact our office at (732) 382-9400 should you have any questions relative to this matter.

Directions to CP Rail Transload Facility

The CP Rail Transload Facility is located in the Oak Island Rail yard which is directly north of the Newark Airport and parallel with I-78. To enter the rail yard, first get on Route 1 & 9. Route 1 & 9 can be accessed by traffic

- From the NORTH using I-95 use Exit 15 W from the western spur or Exit 18 from the eastern spur – follow signs to Route 1 & 9 SOUTH to the Wilson Ave Exit
- From the EAST using I-78 (NJ Turnpike Extension) through Bayonne use Exit 59B, – follow signs to Route 1 & 9 SOUTH to the Wilson Ave Exit
- From EAST using the Pulaski Skyway through Jersey City (which is Route 1 & 9 South when headed toward Newark) to the Wilson Ave Exit
- From the WEST using I-280 exit onto I-95 south – follow signs to Route 1 & 9 SOUTH to the Wilson Ave Exit
- From the WEST using I-78 use Exit 59 B and following signs to Route 1 & 9 NORTH to the Delancy St Exit
- From the SOUTH using I-95 use Exit 14 E and follow the signs for Route 1 & 9 NORTH to the Delancy St Exit

Directions from the Wilson Ave Exit (southbound traffic)

1. At the traffic light at the end of the exit ramp proceed straight and to the left onto Stockton St to the next light (Delancey St),
2. Turn right on Delancey for approximately 0.1 mi where Delancey will make a hard right bend. Do not go right! Go left into drive at signs for “Canadian Pacific RR” and “Craig Adhesives”
3. Proceed straight and follow signs for Canadian Pacific RR, at stop sign make a left.
4. Follow this road for approximately 0.1 mi to a hard left turn; you will see the Canadian Pacific RR sign directing you to make the turn.
5. Proceed approximately 100 yards to a stop sign, this is the Oak Island Yard
6. Pass the group of three trailers on the right follow signs over tracks.
7. Left at sign, follow to trailer on left across from scale on right.

Directions from the Delancey St Exit (northbound traffic)

1. At the traffic light at the end of the exit ramp turn left onto Delancey St.
2. At the next light go straight approximately 0.1 mi where Delancey will make a hard right bend. Do not make the bend.
3. Instead proceed straight (you will see signs for “Canadian Pacific RR” and “Craig Adhesives”
4. Follow this road for approximately 0.1 mi to a hard left turn; you will see the Canadian Pacific RR sign directing you to make the turn.
5. Proceed approximately 100 yards to a stop sign, this is the Oak Island Yard
6. Pass the group of three trailers on the right follow signs over tracks.
7. Left at sign, follow to trailer on left across from scale on right.
