RESOLUTON OF THE UNION COUNTY UTILITIES AUTHORITY AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION FOR THE STATE AND LOCAL CYBERSECURITY GRANT PROGRAM FOR CYBERSECURITY RESOURCES FOR FEDERAL FISCAL YEAR 2024

WHEREAS, the State and Local Cybersecurity Grant Program ("SLCGP") is a federal grant program funded by the U.S. Department of Homeland Security that aims to improve cybersecurity in state and local governments, authorities, school districts and their instrumentalities; and

WHEREAS, in New Jersey, the SLCGP is administered by the New Jersey Office of Homeland Security and Preparedness ("NJOHSP"), wherein the overall goal of the SLCGP is to make state and local government organizations more resilient to cyber threats; and

WHEREAS, for Federal Fiscal Year ("FFY") 2024, SLCGP funds received by NJOHSP to administer the grant will be used to provide hardware, software, and services to state and local government agencies; and

WHEREAS, all New Jersey state and local government entities are eligible to apply for NJ FFY 2024 SLCGP resources, and such entities applying for such resources must also complete and submit the NJ SLCGP Local Consent Agreement.

WHEREAS, the Authority's administration and Finance Committee recommends that an application be submitted on the Authority's behalf to attempt to secure 2024 SLCGP funds as part of the Authority ongoing efforts to augment its existing cyber security infrastructure and further protect its digital records and resources in a cost-effective manner.

NOW, **THEREFORE**, **BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Union County Utilities Authority, as follows:

- 1. The aforesaid recitals are incorporated herein as though fully set forth at length.
- The Acting Executive Director is hereby authorized to execute any and all application(s), documents and/or agreement(s) for the Federal Fiscal Year 2024 SLCGP for Cybersecurity Resources.

- The Acting Executive Director and appropriate Authority staff under her direction, are hereby authorized to submit an application for the Federal Fiscal Year 2024 SLCGP Program for Cybersecurity Resources.
- 4. The Acting Executive Director and appropriate Authority staff under her direction, are further authorized to submit the SLCGP Local Consent Agreement (a sample of which is attached hereto) that is required as part of the aforesaid grant application, and to otherwise undertake such acts as are reasonable and necessary to accomplish the purposes of this Resolution.
- 5. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
